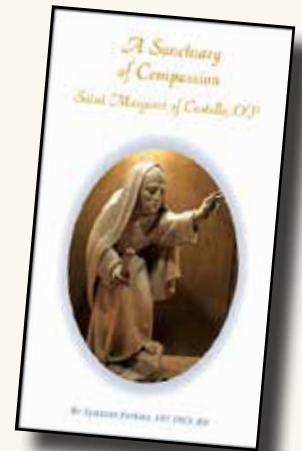


A Sanctuary of Compassion
