
Sanctuary of Compassion


Living the Gospel with St. Martin de Porres

And I Am Afraid of My Dreams

Years later, when she looked back on the Ravensbrück years, Wanda Póltawska did not, for all its horror, regret the experience. Ravensbrück, she said, taught her many things. Not least, it daily brought her face to face with imminent death and made her understand that, for a Christian, all life is a preparation for life after death. She came to understand the real meaning of freedom, that interior freedom of the spirit which soars above circumstances and cannot be destroyed. "I never lost that interior freedom," she says. 

The Seven Penitential Psalms in Time of Pandemic





Rose of Lima: A Blessed Ministry to the Sick Poor



A. It was constituted on May 17, 1727 under the direction of the Master General of the Dominican Order.


